

**Oxford to Cambridge Expressway Western Parishes meeting**

1. Based on the availability of people who responded to the Doodle poll I have now set our next **Oxford to Cambridge Expressway meeting for 7pm on Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> April in the meeting room of Seacourt Hall in Botley** (I.e. the same venue as for our last meeting on the 8<sup>th</sup> March).
2. As previously it would be great if one or two representatives could attend from your Parish Council to continue discussions about plans for opposing the Expressway.
3. Up to now we have been assuming that most, if not all of the Parish Councils along the western/A34 route would be firmly opposing the Expressway, and discussions to date have generally backed up that assumption. It would be helpful, however, if all of you could send a very short summary to me in advance of our meeting stating what your officially agreed position is as a Council.
4. Please use the following 'scores' to indicate overall where your Council sits currently, and then add a few words to cover other relevant information (e.g. member of No Expressway Alliance (or not), links with other relevant organisations, whether you have provided Highways England with details of potential negative impacts from an Expressway running through your parish etc.):
  - 1 = In favour of the Expressway as a whole, regardless of the chosen route
  - 2 = In favour of the Expressway as long as the route doesn't run through your parish
  - 3 = No formal position agreed in Council as yet/No concerns about negative impacts from the Expressway
  - 4 = Actively opposing the Expressway running through your Parish
  - 5 = Actively opposing the Expressway as a whole, regardless of the chosen route.
5. I'm expecting a lot of higher scores, but this will be helpful to get a better picture of what exactly has been agreed by individual Councils as some may well not have formally committed to opposing the Expressway yet.
6. I look forward to hopefully seeing most of you on the 10th.
